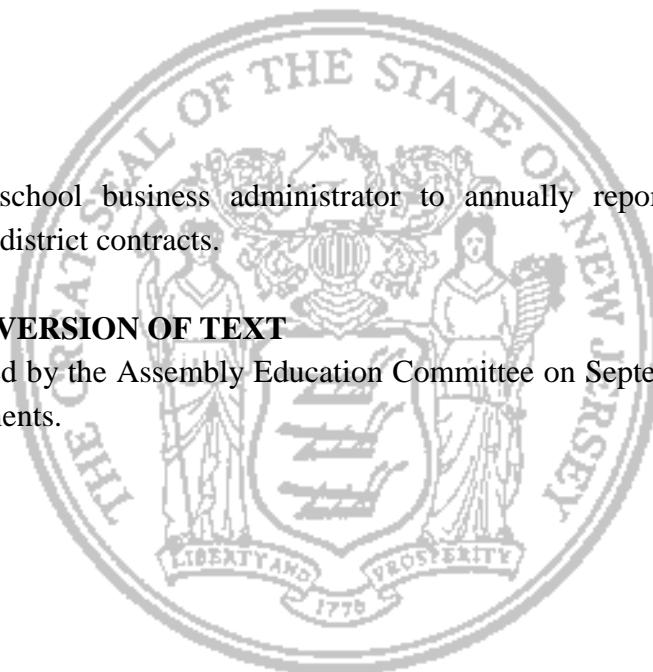

Requires school business administrator to annually report to board of education on district contracts.

1 AN ACT concerning school district contracts and supplementing
2 N.J.S.18A:18A-1 et seq.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. a. By July 1 of each school year, the ¹**superintendent of**
8 **schools** school business administrator¹ shall submit a written
9 report to the board of education on school district contracts. The
10 report shall include: a list of all district contracts that will be
11 awarded, subject to renewal, or expire during the school year; and
12 an explanation of all applicable federal and State laws, rules, and
13 regulations relating to those contracts.

14 b. Prior to the execution, extension, or renewal of any school
15 district contract that was not included in the report prepared
16 pursuant to subsection a. of this section, the ¹**superintendent of**
17 **schools** school business administrator¹ shall notify the board of
18 education in writing of all applicable federal and State laws, rules,
19 and regulations relating to the contract.

21 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
